Title	Genre	Date

Genres

Biography (B)	A story of a real person's life that is written by another person.
Autobiography (AB)	A story of a real person's life that is written by that person.
Informational (I)	Texts that provide facts about a variety of topics (sports, animals, geography, science, history, space).
Realistic Fiction (RF)	A story using made up characters, but could happen in real life.
Historical Fiction (HF)	A fictional story that takes place in the past. The setting is real but the characters are made up.
Science Fiction (SF)	A type of fantasy that uses science and technology.
Mystery (M)	A suspenseful story about a puzzling event that is not solved until the end of the story.
Adventure (A)	A story with adventure or exciting situations involving risk and danger as part of the main storyline.
Comedy (C)	A story that is written to make people laugh.
Poetry (P)	Poetry is verse written to create a response from the reader. It often uses rhythm and rhyme.
Fantasy (F)	A story that includes elements that are impossible such as talking animals or magical powers. (make believe)
Traditional Literature (TL)	Stories that are passed down from one group to another in history. This includes folktales, legends, fables, tall tales and myths from different cultures.
